Coming from the Portland direction or I-95, you will pass a large paper mill on your right side. You will go under a small bridge and our driveway is on the left with the blue lighthouse. Our house is cream colored with blue shudders. You can park right in the front of the yard (and your private door).



If we are not home to welcome you, there is an electronic lock so you can self check in. You will receive a unique passcode either directly from AirBnb or from us. Wake the lock up by touching the display. Enter the code, followed by the check mark (bottom left). To lock the door, make sure it is shut tight (it gives you a little click), and then press the Yale logo button. You will hear the lock close and the display flash if done right.

COFFEE / TEA / SNACKS

We have complimentary coffee and tea for you! For tea, just microwave some water in the mug. There is also an assortment of complimentary snacks in the kitchenette cabinet:)

WATER

Beside complimentary bottled water in the fridge, our water is safe to drink from the faucet.

SHOES

If your shoes are clean and you need to run in and out, feel free keep them on. If it's crappy and messy out, please be friendly to the carpets and take them off.

SHOWER

Left knob controls the water flow, right knob controls the temperature.

There is complimentary shampoo, conditioner, and body wash for you to use.

There is a rack with fresh clean towels in front of the bathroom on the left side.

When departing, just leave the used towels on the bathroom floor.

GETTING AROUND WITHOUT A CAR

Uber and Lyft are around and cost about \$15 to get downtown (takes about 15-20 minutes).

SMOKING

There is no smoking allowed in the house. You can smoke outside away from the house. Just dispose of your butts. We are 420 friendly and it's legal in Maine but please keep it outside.

HEAT

There is a Rinnai heater right next to the door. If you are cold, plug it in, press the ON button and adjust the temperature with the up and down buttons. Please don't run the heater with the windows or door open.

AIR CONDITIONING

The unit up on the wall in the corner is not an air conditioner but a heat pump. It works in reverse in the summer as an air conditioner and dehumidifier but any adjustments to it take hours to take effect. We have it set at a comfortable temperature and ask that you don't make any adjustments to it. Please let us know if you want us to make any changes.

TRASH / RECYCLE

There are trash cans in the bathroom and in the kitchenette.

Paper, plastics, and metals all get recycled here.

Bottle containers are deposit redeemable in Maine. Beer, wine, water, whiskey, milk, soda...

Please put all recyclables in the blue container under the porch that says "City of Portland recycles."

GAMES

There is a wide range of games in the second room by the dining table. Feel free to play any of them!

PING PONG

We have a ping pong table in the garage that you are welcome to use. There is also a dart board. We both accept any challenges!

FIRE PIT

We love having a fire!

If we're around and weather permitting, we are game!

Please don't start any fires if we are not present.

CAT

We have a partially Maine Coon black cat, Luna. She is very social and will visit if you let her. If you don't care for cats and she gets in, just put her outside. If you like a new fluffy friend, feel free to hang out.

CONVENIENCE STORES

If you take a right from the driveway, 0.6 mile down the road is Walgreens. Open 8am-9pm daily.

GROCERY STORES

There are two grocery stores within a 5 minute drive: Hannafords and Market Basket. Food delivery is also available!

LAUNDRY

Please ask first if you need to do laundry. We charge a fee for each load. If you're staying for more than 5 nights, we will waive the fee.
